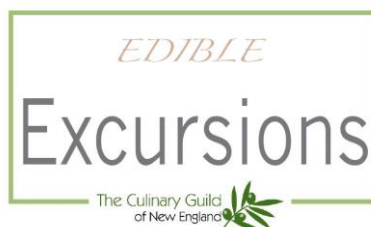
Location: A market near Nibble Kitchen, 1 Bow Market Way, Somerville
